HOUSE POLICY

The Picton Bowling Club promotes the
Responsible Service of Alcohol:

1. The Club shall not supply liquor to a person under the age of 18 years. The club will insist on viewing valid I.D. upon entry into the Club and whilst present within the club.
2. The Club shall not permit patrons to become intoxicated. Staff are trained to identify the signs of intoxication and will refuse service and you will be asked to leave the premises.
3. The Club Shall not sell or supply liquor to any person deemed intoxicated.
4. The Club reserves the right to refuse entry to any person's deemed intoxicated.
5. The Club has a zero Tolerance on the following aspects:
Indecent Behavior
Violent Behavior
Quarrelsome Behavior
Abusive Behavior
These behaviors will not be tolerated towards any Staff member or other Patrons
6. The Club Promotes the service of non -Alcohol drinks and always will have food available.

CLUB RULES

CHILDREN

Parents are responsible for the supervision & control of their children at all times, whilst on the Club premises. Children are not permitted to run wild through the Club, sit at tables unattended, remove their footwear, approach or order from the bar service areas or enter any part of the restricted areas.

Parents please consider other members and guests who do not wish to have their Club visit disrupted by unruly children.

FOOD & BEVERAGES

Liquor licensing laws and the Registered Clubs Act prohibit any individual bringing food and beverages onto Club premises, with the exception of specialty cakes, approved by management for special functions.

VISITORS

A guest must remain in the company of the member whilst in the Club. The member shall be responsible for the good behavior of their guest and shall ensure that the Constitution of the Club is observed.

This is an important article and must not be given to anyone else. Each time you enter the Club, your membership card must be shown to the door person on duty, If you live within 5km radius of the Club (as the crow fly's) by law, you must be a member of this Club.
